Membership and Participation

The Middle Tennessee Orphan Alliance (MTOA) welcomes all Christian denominations, adoption agencies and orphan ministries in the Middle Tennessee area to join us in working for the cause of orphaned, abandoned and at-risk children everywhere. We meet monthly to pray, encourage one another, share successes and discuss ideas.

Formal membership is not required to participate in MTOA monthly meetings, but provides many benefits, including but not limited to the following: group event exhibitor, community partner recommendation, website visibility.

Membership Requirements

For organizations, the following membership steps are required:

1. Thoroughly read and prayerfully consider the Middle Tennessee Orphan Alliance (MTOA) Organization Membership requirements included in this packet.
2. Complete and submit the MTOA Organization Membership Application.
3. Read, accept and sign the MTOA Statement of Faith.
4. Acknowledge and accept the vision, purpose and direction of MTOA by completing the MTOA Membership Agreement.
5. Provide proof of membership within the Christian Alliance for Orphans (CAFO) or at a minimum, provide documentation to show application for non-profit status (EIN number, charter, etc.).
6. Keep in mind that while networking is certainly encouraged, sometimes during meetings we “leave logos at the door” to ensure the children for whom we’re advocating remain the top priority.
7. Submit forms to a MTOA Board Member for review.
8. For membership to remain active, attend three (3) MTOA meetings per year.

Upon receipt of the above mentioned items, applicants will be considered provisional members until officially approved by the MTOA Board. Applicants will receive notification of acceptance by email.
